ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES (APS)

The Adult Protective Services Unit (APS) is designed to investigate cases of abuse, neglect and exploitation. An APS investigation is a thorough assessment of a potential at-risk adult.

AGING AND DISABILITIES RESOURCE CONNECTION (ADRC)

The ADRC provides assessments and case management services to seniors and individuals with disabilities.

CAREGIVER SUPPORT GROUP

A group which meets on a regular basis, formed to help relieve caregiver stress and to provide peer support, education and information to caregivers, both elderly and non-elderly, of older persons.

FIX-IT PROGRAM

The Fix-It Program is available to any senior citizen 60 or older, whose safety is at risk due to the need of handrails and minor home repairs, enabling them to remain living at home.

HOME CARE SERVICES

The AAA/ADRC provides case management services to eligible individuals seeking to remain in the community rather than live in a long-term care facility through the use of specific home and community-based services and informal supports.

LEGAL SERVICES

South Jersey Legal Services provides free legal assistance to older and disabled residents such as landlord/tenant issues, wills and living wills, food stamp appeals, domestic matters and consumer fraud matters.

MEALS CONGREGATE – 10 SENIOR CENTERS

Site Location provides a meal which contains at least 1/3 the Dietary Reference Intake (DRI) . Sites assist participant of benefits under other programs. Sites provide recreational, informational and/or health-related programs and activities.

HOME DELIVERED MEALS

Specific to those home bound, offering a meal which contains at least 1/3 the Dietary Reference Intake (DRI). Helps social contact, reduces isolation, and improves quality of life.

MEDICAL and SOCIAL DAY CARE

This structure program offers assistance to any senior or disabled citizen who requires care and supervision in a protective setting for a portion of the day, with emphasis on the physically or cognitively impaired older adults.

STATE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM (SHIP)

Trained Staff provide counseling and assistance to seniors and disabled persons on Medicare regulations and explanations on supplemental, prescription drug plans, Advantage Plans and Medigap insurance policies. Counselors are available by phone or by appointment. SHIP Counselors are also available for home visits or group presentations.
